



Montgomery Lodge Scholarship Application

To be an eligible applicant, you must be a **CHILD** or **GRANDCHILD** of a current member of good standing or deceased member of Montgomery Lodge A.F. & A.M. Please identify this Mason on the application.

To be eligible, all scholarship applications must be **emailed by April 30th**. The selection process will begin shortly thereafter and recipients of the Montgomery Lodge Scholarship Awards will be notified in May.

Checks for the awards will be payable to the student after evidence indicating enrollment for the first semester of the academic year is received by the Lodge secretary. A receipted **tuition bill** (i.e., paid) for the semester charges will suffice for evidence of enrollment. Checks will be mailed in August after receipt of proof of enrollment.

Scholarship winners may be invited to be the Lodge's guest at an awards ceremony to be held in late June or at our annual Installation of Officers at the WM's discretion. Names of winners may be shared on social or printed media.

The eligibility requirements for a Montgomery Lodge A.F. & A.M. Scholarship are as follows:

1. Scholarships will be awarded only to high school graduates (or soon to be graduates) that are enrolled full time in a course of higher education at an accredited two or four year college. Before the scholarship is awarded, the applicant must provide proof of enrollment in the form of a paid tuition bill to our Lodge Secretary before any payment will be awarded.
2. Each applicant must submit a personal letter in which the applicant sets forth his or her reasons for entering or continuing their higher education.
3. The applicant must furnish a current transcript from his or her high school or higher education institution, together with a testimonial from the principal, guidance counselor, teacher or advisor, as to their attendance and character.
4. The basis for the scholarships will be, but not limited to, the following criteria:
(A) Economic Need (B) Scholastic Standing (C) Extracurricular Activities
5. All scholarship applications are for one year. Applications for subsequent scholarships may be made in succeeding years. However, preference will be given to graduating high school seniors entering their first year of higher education and those having never received past scholarship awards.
